Our Mission

Class Size/Ratios

We have a classroom capacity of 28 students. During all three of our sessions (Morning Half-Day, Afternoon Half-Day, Full Day), we have two Montessori certified

teachers and one classroom assistant. As a result, a wide range of support is provided to the classroom.

Our Montessori school in Columbia Maryland is accredited with the American Montessori Society and the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools. We hold a Maryland State Board of Education Certificate. Our Kindergarten program is certified by the Maryland State Department of Education. Additionally, we are also a member of the Montessori Schools of Maryland.

School Governance

The Board of Trustees, consisting of community members and current parents, is responsible for the policies and overall financial management of our Montessori school in Columbia MD. The Executive Director implements the policies and is responsible for the overall daily operation of the school. 


Joanne Alme
